

Minutes of Committee Meeting of 2.1.2021

1. **Tourist Tax**

Out of 1'022 invoices sent, there were about 100 protests that will need to be assessed on site with the owners. Taking into account the fact that second homes are often the property of several people (husband and wife, heirs etc.) we estimate that there are about 2'000 secondary residents in Vercorin.

2. **Vercorin Tourisme SA (VTSA) ... (refers to the Tourism Ltd Co)**

Our benefit booklet proposals will be discussed at the next VTSA Board meeting.

Arthur Clivaz, the current chairman of VTSA, has been chosen (from 45 candidates) as director of the three companies, namely SA Télécabine Vercorin, VTSA and SA Téléférique Chalais-Vercorin. He will report to a coordination board composed of the presidents of the three companies and the president of the Commune. VTSA will have to find a new president.

3. **Subscription for the SA Télécabine Vercorin**

Seven people bought shares following our call. There is a shortfall of about 300'000 francs.

4. **The Alternative Project of the Chalais-Vercorin Cable Car**

It does not inspire us. It singularly degrades the view from Vercorin to the Val d'Anniviers and does not do justice to the interests of the schoolchildren, who need to use the cable-car throughout the year. We note that to the tourist activity, by comparison, is limited to a few months.

5. **General Assembly of February 20th 2021**

The GA will take place in the large hall of the school of Vercorin if sanitary conditions allow it. We have decided to offer members the possibility to also attend the GA by Zoom if they wish. The new president of the Municipality, Mrs. Sylvie Masserey Anselin has agreed to come and talk to us about her plans for the future of the Municipality.

Our finances are healthy. We currently have about 5'600 francs on our account, with about 110 paying members.

We will take advantage of the presence of the President of the Municipality to arrange a meeting between our Committee and the Municipality to discuss various issues (sewage, water and garbage taxes, waste disposal, street lighting, etc.).

6. **Miscellaneous**

While moving the location of the village's fountain has not been a problem, there is strong disapproval of the aesthetics of the new fountain.
