

## Minutes of Committee Meeting of 17.10.2020

### 1. Statement of contributions

We currently have 107 paying members. The 5 people who have not paid after two reminders will be informed that they will no longer be part of Verco R2.

### 2. Tourism Vercorin SA (Ltd Co)

- The SA has chosen a landscaping company from Sion to carry out the Creux du Lavioz landscaping project. The project proposed by this company seems quite attractive. The work will be financed by Vercorin Tourisme SA and by the Municipality. The realization will take place during next year (2021). Jacques sent us the two projects that caught the SA's attention.
- The SA must also find a director who will be responsible for the management of the cable car, the tourist office and the Chalais-Vercorin cable car.
- The offer of the benefit booklets will be changed and Claire will send us the results of her research on this subject. Among the different ideas raised during the discussion, the provision of vouchers for trips to and from the cable car or for meals at the Crêt du midi restaurant was mentioned.

### 3. Development Society

The document Martine sent us is very explicit. The SD is in the process of being put in place, an implementation that requires a little time. The organization of the various events obviously depends on the situation of the pandemic and all planning is therefore suspended for the moment.

### 4. Mobility and Prefecture

There were no further meetings and the next meeting is scheduled for early next year (January 2021).

### 5. Village's Street Lights

Everybody agrees that the street lights are misdirected and need to be fixed. We will discuss this at the next meeting with the municipal authorities.

### 6. Meeting with the Municipal Authorities

The main topics to be discussed are water, sewer and garbage taxes and street lights. The progress of the investment projects of the Vercorin SA cable car and the Chalais-Vercorin cable car project could also be discussed.

7. The next meeting of the Committee will take place between Christmas and New Year, depending on the availability of the municipal authorities.
